### **PROCEDURE FOR QUALIFYING FOR COUNTY BADGE**

All Players reaching Semi-finals who have played a minimum of three rounds including Divisional Final in Singles, Pairs, Triples, Fours and Two-Wood will qualify for their County Badge.

Unbadged Players competing in Singles, Pairs, Triples, Fours, Two-Wood on County Finals Day will be presented with their County Badge by the President on the Green.

The Winner of the Maude Woods (Unbadged) and the Winners of the Senior Fours competition will also be presented with their County Badge.

All other Players qualifying will be given a game and County Badge the following year.

If the Kent President qualifies for her County Badge in her year of office, she will be presented with this on Finals Day the same year.

Any Kent Player being awarded her Senior Bowls England Cap, and is not badged, will be awarded her **KCBA** Badge

If a Senior Vice-President has qualified for her County Badge, she will be awarded this on taking office as Kent President and not have to wait the required time to be given her badge.
